2. In the tomb, the kids spot artwork depicting the pharaoh <u>AKHENATEN</u> and his favorite god, <u>THE ATEN</u> , on page(s)
The Aten is depicted as a sun disc with rays as arms and claw-like hands. Akhenaten tried to force ancient Egyptians to worship the Aten, rather than the traditional gods and goddesses.
3. When Aria touches the <u>ANKH AMULET</u> on page, she and Jagger fall over 3,000 years back in time to the fantastical court of Amarna, Egypt.
Ancient Egyptians used amulets to improve their health, help them achieve life goals, and as a form of protection.
4. Jagger and Aria are stunned when Princess Meretaten, aka Tatia, uses a HORUS EYE amulet and an ISIS KNOT amulet, on pages and, in her magic spells.
Isis was a very popular goddess. Horus was her son. His father was Osiris.
5. At the court in ancient Amarna, Jagger gets a sneak peek at the future pharaoh,





7. Traveling on the Nile, Jagger and Aria learn how to play **SENET** on page _____.

Senet was a popular board game.

8. Sneaking into an ancient Egyptian temple isn't easy, but Jagger's knowledge of <u>FESTIVAL FLOATS</u> and an <u>ORACLE STATUE</u> comes in handy on pages and .

Statues of the gods were moved back and forth between temples in floats. These festivals were a nice way for the gods to visit each other.

9. On page , while sneaking through a temple at night, Aria steps on a **HEARING EAR**.

Many Egyptians weren't allowed access to the most sacred parts of the temples. Some people would pray outside of the temple. Some left clay ears, designed to help the god hear their prayers.

10. There were no grocery bags in ancient Egypt, so when Jagger needs a place to store valuables while stuck in a tomb, he uses **CANOPIC JARS** on page .

Canopic Jars were designed to hold the viscera of the deceased. They were shown with different heads—commonly the four sons of Horus—and held the stomach, intestines, liver and lungs.

11. When Tatia needs some magical helpers, **SHABTI** spring to life on page _____ to give her a hand.


Shabti were small figurines designed to take care of the deceased in the afterlife.

12. Herihor uses a <u>MAGIC WAND</u> inscribed with creatures of chaos in a spell on page _____.

These ivory wands were inscribed with fearsome gods and creatures like snakes, frogs, and scorpions.

13. Jagger and Aria run into the goddess <u>MERETSEGER</u> on page(s) _____.

Meretseger was the goddess of the Theban peak who protected the resting place of the pharaohs.
